RESOLUTION NO. 2014-31-1013
ESTABLISHING PROTOCOL AND PROCEDURE FOR MAINTAINING ORDER AT CITY COUNCIL
MEETINGS.

TO: CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF CROSBY AND ALL PERSONS ATTENDING CROSBY CITY
COUNCIL MEETINGS.

WHEREAS, the City of Crosby is authorized pursuant to Minn. Stat. §412.191, subd. 2,
to preserve order at its meetings; and

WHEREAS, meetings are open to the public, however, no person is entitled to be loud
or disorderly in the council chambers during council meetings;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY the City Council of the City of Crosby, Crow Wing
County, Minnesota, as follows:

1. No person shall engage in disorderly conduct which disrupts or interferes with
the transaction of City Council business;
2. All persons shall remain seated and quiet in the council chamber unless called
upon to speak, in which case said person shall move to the podium and speak on the issue or
matter before the council;
3. That the City of Crosby hereby establishes the following protocol for
maintaining order at council meetings;
 - a. All persons attending council meetings shall remain seated and quiet
and shall conduct themselves with courtesy, respect, and decorum or shall be removed
from the council chamber after one warning. No person shall engage in disorderly
conduct which disrupts or interferes with the transaction of City Council business;
 - b. Any person who becomes disorderly, unruly, loud, boisterous, or
obnoxious so as to make it impossible or impractical to carry on or properly conduct
the council meeting, shall be verbally warned by the Mayor or Acting Mayor to cease
and desist in such conduct;
 - c. After said verbal warning, any person(s) in attendance, who fails to
quiet themselves or continues to act in a disorderly manner, shall be removed, by
order of the Mayor or Acting Mayor, from the council chamber by a member of the
Crosby Police Department.
