Mayor Cash called the workshop of the Crosby City Council to order at 5:00 PM

1. Parking ordinance

- A.** Administrator Hill reviewed the activity to date with the meeting minutes, proposals, and ordinances. He also included a sample of language to be considered.
- B.** Administrator Hill asked the Council to define the issue. The council doesn't want to hurt working people of the community. Chief Rooney reminded the council that parking violations are not complaint driven. Consensus of the council is that the issue is vehicles parking on city streets for over 72 hours without being moved.
- C.** Administrator Hill was directed to providing updated language to the council for review at the next council meeting including that vehicles can't park for 72 consecutive hours; must be moved at least 300 feet; cannot return within seven (7) days.
