



## APPLICATION FOR PEDDLERS/SOLICITORS

### Permit Fee: \$40.00 per day

Application for a city permit to conduct business as a peddler shall be made at least fourteen (14) regular business days before the applicant desires to conduct business. Application for permit shall be made on this form approved by the city council from the office of the city clerk. All applications shall include the following information:

*City license required. Pursuant to M.S. § 437.02, as it may be amended from time to time, except as otherwise provided for by this chapter, no person shall conduct business as either a peddler without first having obtained a license from the city. Solicitors need not be licensed, but are still required to register pursuant to § 112.07. FEES DO NOT APPLY TO SOLICITORS.*

**§112.01 PEDDLER. A person who goes from house-to-house, door-to-door, business-to-business, street-to-street, or any other type of place-to-place movement, for the purpose of offering for sale, displaying or exposing for sale, selling or attempting to sell, and delivering immediately upon sale, the goods, wares, products, merchandise or other personal property that the person is carrying or otherwise transporting. The term PEDDLER shall mean the same as the term "hawker."**

**SOLICITOR. A person who goes from house-to-house, door-to-door, business-to-business, street-to-street, or any other type of place-to-place movement, for the purpose of obtaining or attempting to obtain orders for goods, wares, products, merchandise, other personal property or services of which he or she may be carrying or transporting samples, or that may be described in a catalog or by other means, and for which delivery or performance shall occur at a later time. The absence of samples or catalogs shall not remove a person from the scope of this provision if the actual purpose of the person's activity is to obtain or attempt to obtain orders as discussed above. The term shall mean the same as the term "canvasser."**

**§ 112.08 PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES.**

**No peddler, solicitor or transient merchant shall conduct business in any of the following manners:**

- (A) Calling attention to his or her business or items to be sold by means of blowing any horn or whistle, ringing any bell, crying out, or by any other noise, so as to be unreasonably audible within an enclosed structure.**
- (B) Obstructing the free flow of either vehicular or pedestrian traffic on any street, alley, sidewalk or other public right-of-way.**
- (C) Conducting business in a way as to create a threat to the health, safety and welfare of any individual or the general public.**
- (D) Conducting business before 7:00 a.m. or after 9:00 p.m.**
- (E) Failing to provide proof of license or registration, and identification, when requested; or using the license or registration of another person.**
- (F) Making any false or misleading statements about the product or service being sold, including untrue statements of endorsement. No peddler, solicitor or transient merchant shall claim to have the endorsement of the city solely based on the city having issued a license or certificate of registration to that person.**
- (G) Remaining on the property of another when requested to leave, or to otherwise conducting business in a manner a reasonable person would find obscene, threatening, intimidating or abusive.**

## **TENNESSEN WARNING PEDDLER PERMIT APPLICATION**

Minnesota law requires that you be informed of the purposes and intended uses of the information you provide to the City of Crosby (the City) during the permit application process.

Any information about yourself that you provide to the City during the permit application process will be used to identify you as an applicant and to assess your qualifications for obtaining a transient merchant/peddler permit within the City. If you wish to be considered for a transient merchant/peddler permit, you are required to provide the information requested in the permit application. If you refuse to supply information requested by the City, it may mean that your application will not be considered.
